Responsibilities

- Recruiting new and experienced participants and teaching healthy ringing techniques.

- Leading weekly rehearsals and conducting the choir in worship appearances at least once per month between September and June.
- Planning and group participation in special handbell gatherings and events.
- Active involvement in Music Ministry team meetings and initiatives.
- Examine possibilities of establishing a children or youth handbell ensemble.
