### A MESSAGE FROM THE OFFICE OF THE BISHOP

Dear Beloved People of The Ohio Episcopal Area,

I write to you today with a heavy heart and a praying spirit as we witness the recent tragic deaths of two people in Minnesota. These losses are not isolated incidents. They are part of a wider pattern of fear-driven, indiscriminate immigration enforcement that has crossed moral and spiritual boundaries. Nothing can justify violence against human life.

As an immigrant myself, I know in my own body what it means to live under the weight of uncertainty, vulnerability, and being labeled. I also know that many who are called "undocumented" are not criminals. They are workers, parents, and neighbors who crossed borders because economic systems, political violence, and family survival left them no other choice. Today, families, industries, and entire communities in the United States depend on their labor and their lives. This is why we must continue to call for **comprehensive immigration reform** that reflects reality, justice, and mercy.

Scripture is unambiguous about God's heart toward the stranger.

"When a stranger resides with you in your land, you shall not oppress the stranger. The stranger who resides with you shall be to you as the citizen among you; you shall love the stranger as yourself" (Leviticus 19:33-34). [Continue reading Bishop Jung's letter...](#)



In November 2024 the first Ohio Episcopal Area Green Church training was held, helping local churches take steps to better care for God's creation in their

congregations and communities. In 2025, three additional Green Church Trainings were held – in Columbus, Ashland, and online. A total of 47 churches attended the trainings from both East and West Ohio – typically with a team of two or three people from each church. Virtual Sessions will be via Zoom on Wednesdays: 7/8, 7/15, 7/22, 7/29 from 7-9pm and


Thursdays: 7/9, 7/16, 7/23, 7/30 from 10am-noon using the same curriculum.

#### **Church Investment and Legacy Academy**



Scholarships are available to high school seniors planning to enroll in post-secondary education (including vocational, professional, or academic studies -- not limited to colleges or universities) or students currently enrolled in a program pursuing an Associate or Bachelor's degree. At least nine, \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to **primary** members of an Ohio Credit Union that has branches located in Hamilton, Butler, Warren, Clermont, Brown, or Adams counties, including the Christian Family Credit Union. 
